

Teacher Certification Program for College Graduates

Hybrid and In-Person Cohorts

This full-time, 11-month, 48-49-credit teacher certification and master's program offers a hybrid in-person/online cohort at UConn Stamford and fully in-person cohorts at UConn's Avery Point, Hartford, and Waterbury campuses.

- Overall GPA of 2.7

Paid Internships and Scholarships Available

TCPCG offers a residency program in several school districts that includes a paid internship. The residency is comprised of 5 days a week in a select school district with a minimum of 14 hours a week in your specified content area. The residency program begins in late August and ends in mid-January. Current districts include:

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How to Apply to the TCPCG Program:

December 15 Priority Admission

March 15 Regular Admission

Admission Requirements:

- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution
- 36 credits in the subject area in which you wish to teach (up to 12 related credits can be included for most subjects; see program guidelines)
- A 3-credit survey course in U.S. history; see approved course list
- 39 credits of general education courses, including courses in five of the following areas: (English, natural sciences, mathematics, social studies, world languages, fine arts)
- Materials for your application to <u>UConn's Graduate School</u>

Prior to starting the program, students must pass the <u>Praxis II</u> <u>subject assessment</u> or <u>ACTFL tests</u> (World Language students).

Praxis® Core Requirement:

Once admitted to TCPCG, students must take the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators test, or else obtain a waiver. In order to waive Praxis Core, submit qualifying scores from the ACT, GRE, or SAT.

Learn more about the <u>Praxis Core requirement</u> and your eligibility for a waiver. Please note: Although there are minimum passing standards, students do not need to achieve the passing score in order to enter TCPCG.

Summer Session I and II*

- In-person classes 4 days a week, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Clinical observations 1 day a week

Fall Semester:

- Online classes 3-4 days a week
- In-person class 1 Saturday a month
- Internship, 15 hours a week in a school district

Spring Semester:

- Online seminar 1 day a week
- In-person seminar 1 Saturday a month
- 1 online course (special ed only)
- Full-time student teaching

Summer Session I and II*

- In-person classes 4 days a week, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Clinical observations 1 day a week Fall Semester:
 - Evening classes 2-3 nights a week

- Evening class 1 night a week
- Full-time student teaching
