## Planning for the dual degree with CLAS GenEds and Neag required courses

- Content Area One (CA1) Five courses are required for CLAS, including one from each of the areas A-D; a fifth course from any area A-E; courses must be from at least four different academic units
- CA1B- ENGL 2100
- CA1C- HIST 1501 or 1502
- CA1E- a second ENGL course from CA1B that overlaps with list above
- Environmental Literacy ENGL 2635E and 3240E apply as Genre courses. Other options include selecting a course that overlaps with CA1D or Content Area 2
- Content Area Three non-lab: PSYC 1100
- Content Area Three Lab: For some students PHYS 1010Q or 1025Q are a good option to satisfy 3rd Q for CLAS along with the lab; however, this depends on student's science proficiency
- Content Area Four-International, select a course that overlaps with NEAG's International Requirement\*\*
- Content Area Four- The second CA4 should double dip with CA1A or Content Area Two

## \*\*Students following catalog year 2021 & 2022

- For efficiency and to cover requirements, it is recommended
  - o That one Neag American Lit course be selected that overlaps with Antiracism, Globality, and Embodiment from the English major
  - o That one Neag International Lit course be selected that overlaps with Antiracism, Globality, and Embodiment from the English major
  - At least one of the Neag American or International Lit courses must apply toward Group One of Antiracism, Globality and Embodiment
  - o That one Neag Genre course overlap with an Environmental Literacy GenEd (2635E or 3240E)
