## **Block Transfer**

## Policy:

- Students who earn an associate's degree at CT State that has been determined as "Transfer Oriented" by UConn (website forthcoming for these designations; Currently approved programs are <u>Liberal Arts & Sciences</u>, <u>Associate of Arts [LASC-AA]</u> and Liberal Arts & Sciences, Associate of Science [LASC-AS]) are able to have University general education (Common Curriculum) requirements waived.
  - Block Transfer does not:
    - Guarantee Admission -- applications are still holistically reviewed for competitive admission.
    - Waive prerequisites
    - Waive School and College degree requirements
    - Waive any other major specific degree requirements.
  - o Course by course articulations will still happen
    - Credits are only issued for courses earning a "C" or above.

## Procedure:

- Students will have "External Degree" in PeopleSoft entered as "AA (Block Transfer)" or "AS (Block Transfer)" note: This will not be available until mid-June (projected)
- The "Degree status" will show as:
  - o "Complete" if degree has been earned (and we have a final transcript)
  - o "In Progress" if student should earn it, but we do not have a final transcript
    - These students will also have courses IP from the external education as a well.
  - o "Discontinued" if student will not earn the degree.
- The degrees and status will create "Student Groups" by the Registrar's office (similar to bachelor's degree holders) which will be visible on the Advising Report.
